# LEAPS 2.0

Co-Curricular Attainment	Details
Good (1 bonus point)	<p>Attains a minimum <u>Level 1</u> in all four domains with any one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- At least Level 2 in three domains;</li><li>- At least Level 2 in one domain and at least Level 3 in another domain; or</li><li>- At least Level 4 in one domain.</li></ul>

# Early Admission Exercise (EAE)

- Allows students to apply for and receive conditional offers for admission prior to their **GCE O-Level Examinations**
- 20% of Academic Year intake from 5 Polytechnics
- Application period: June – July (Year of study in Sec 4)

# Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- Allows polytechnic-bound N(A) students for entry into the relevant Polytechnic Diploma courses
- Bonus points will be awarded for good CCA grades (used in computing the ELMAB3 within the PFP)
- Application period: January (after N Levels exams)

# Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- Allows **Secondary 4N(A)** students to be admitted directly into a two-year *Higher Nitec* programme at the Institute of Technical Education (ITE) without having to sit for the O-Level examinations or undergo a *Nitec* programme
- Guaranteed a place in one of the polytechnic diploma courses that are mapped to their *Higher Nitec* course (must attain the required minimum qualifying GPA)
- Application period: Upon release of the GCE N-Level examination results


