INFORMATION AND PROGRAMMES FOR TERM 1 2021

A warm welcome to the new academic year! 2020 had been a difficult year for many of us and we hope for 2021 to provide better times and meaningful opportunities. As the new Principal and on behalf of the school, I would like to wish you a happy and peaceful 2021! To all our Changkateers, a warm welcome back, and to our new students, we welcome you to our Changkat family! We look forward to an exciting year of learning with you.

Prior to my appointment as new Principal of the school, I was the Vice-Principal at Manjusri Secondary School and had recently completed the Leaders in Education Programme at National Institute of Education. I am humbled to have the opportunity to lead this school and I would like to thank Ms Sharma Poonam and Principals before her for their strong leadership in enabling the school to go from strength to strength. My team and I will continue to build on their fine work and keep the Changkat Changi flag flying high!

Our school continues to uphold our mission of developing your child/ward holistically. The recently released 'N'-Level results show that our efforts in prioritising your child's/ward's well-being especially in the COVID-19 year paid off. Many subjects have performed better than last year's percentage passes, including subjects such as English, Science, Humanities, and Chinese language. In particular, both Principles of Accounts and Art have achieved 100% passes. This is an affirmation of the hard work our teachers have put in to support our students in Education and Career Guidance.

Beyond academic performance, the school will continue on a series of initiatives for our students' holistic development. Changkateers can look forward to a richer learning experience through the implementation of Positive Education, Blended Learning and use of a new facility – Dream Lab. We will focus our efforts to strengthen the Changkateer Graduate Outcomes while being anchored on school values, iCAR²E (integrity, Care, GrAtitude, Respect, Resilience, Excellence). Our school believes that every child can achieve success through effort and resilience, and that as a Changkat family, we can all encourage one another to develop and grow.

Established in 1966, Changkat Changi Secondary School has come a long way. As we celebrate our 55th Anniversary in 2021, it also marks 20 years since our relocation to the current premises at 23 Simei Street 3 in 2001. The Simei community has welcomed us warmly in these past 20 years and we look forward to working closely with our community as we scale new heights.

Our school motto 'Through School to Nation' reminds us that Changkat Changi plays an important role to cultivate responsible and committed citizens for a cohesive society. Our work at Changkat Changi is not yet complete but I believe that together, we can achieve our Vision. We will therefore remember 2021 by celebrating our heritage and achievements and, at the same time, welcoming and realising our dreams of past, present and future Changkateers.



Parents and the greater community are our key partners in this endeavour. We look forward to a meaningful year ahead as we enable new opportunities and scale greater heights together as one Changkat Changi family in 2021!

As we look ahead to the new academic year, the following items are highlighted in this letter for your information:

1 Ensuring Safety and Security of Students

- 1.1 In preparation for the new academic year, we would like to emphasize the importance of continued vigilance by all to prevent a second wave of COVID-19 infections. The following Safe Management Measures (SMM) will continue to be put in place to minimize the risk of confirmed cases from entering the school and to prevent any potential spread in all aspects of school life:
 - daily temperature-taking and visual screening will be carried out for all students and staff. Students are reminded to have their Oral Digital Thermometer with them in school.
 - practicing social responsibility (e.g. wiping down of common items after use, importance of mask-wearing, not coming to school if unwell or if household members are unwell with flu-like symptoms).
 - all staff and visitors will be required to register their details via SafeEntry when entering the school.
 - practising good personal hygiene (e.g observance of regular hand-washing)
 - high-touch surfaces will be cleaned more frequently and our premises will be disinfected daily.
 - observing safe distancing measures at all times both in school and out of school.
 Intermingling across classes and levels will be minimised.
 - fixed exam-style seating in classrooms and spaced seating in canteens or alternative venues will be implemented.
 - recess timings will be staggered by levels to reduce congestion and students are encouraged to pack food from home. Snack breaks will still be provided at 1.15pm on Tuesdays to Thursdays and students are to wash their hands with soap and water before and after consumption of their snack.
 - dismissal timings will be staggered to reduce congestion. Students are advised to head straight home once dismissed and not to congregate in groups at public areas.

1.2 Building of Sheltered Walkway by Land Transport Authority (LTA)

We are pleased to inform you that LTA has resumed work to build a sheltered walkway from Simei MRT to our school's front gate and that of Changkat Primary School, including the pathway opposite of the school. It is estimated that the walkway will be fully operational by the second quarter of 2021. Do encourage your child/ward to take note of potential safety hazards in their journey to school while construction is taking place.

1.3 Road Safety

Parents/guardians are encouraged to remind your child/ward on the importance of road safety inside and outside of the school. We seek your understanding to follow the



correct traffic flow within the school compound and drop your child/ward only at the designated drop-off point at the foyer. To reduce congestion during wet weather, parents/ guardians are to proceed toward the furthest end of the drop-off point so that more cars can be accommodated under the shelter. Parents/Guardians are also reminded that right turns at the school gate is prohibited from 6.30 am to 8.00 am. If your child/ward is taking public transport, please also remind him/her to use the zebra crossings and designated footpaths when they are walking from the gate to the school building.

2 Teaching and Learning

2.1 School Hours

Please find below the school hours for 2021. We will continue to stagger dismissal timings by level to reduce transient congestion during school dismissal. Do encourage your child to arrive in school 10 minutes before time.

2.2 a) School-based Assessment and Weightings

In line with MOE's School-based Assessment Policy, Weighed Assessments (WA) will be conducted once a term for Term 1 to Term 3 for Secondary One to Three students. There will only be one End-of-Year Examinations (EOY) in Term 4.

For Secondary Four/Five students, there will be two main examinations - Mid Year Examinations (MYE) in Term 2 and Preliminary Examinations starting Term 3.

The weightings of the respective school-based assessments for 2021 are summarised below for your reference:

- A weighted assessment (WA) refers to an assessment for which scores attained count towards the subject grade. It can be a class test, performance task, portfolio, practical test or alternative assessments such as projects, etc.

3. Holistic Development of Students

3.1 Kickstart! Programme (4 to 8 January)

To signal the importance of strong peer support and class spirit in shaping a positive school experience, we will start the year with the Kickstart! Programme for all levels. Form Teachers will also have the opportunity to forge strong teacher-student relationships with the class from the beginning of the school year. A summary of the activities, and arrival and dismissal timings can be found in Annex A.

3.2 Sec 1 CCA Orientation and Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC)

All Sec 1 students will be participating in the Sec 1 CCA Orientation on 22 January from 2.30 to 5.00 pm to know more about the CCAs offered in our school. This will allow them to make informed decisions on their choice of CCAs.

In conjunction with CCA Orientation, a Sec 1 PTC via Zoom will be held on 23 January from 9.00 to 10.30 am. Parents will have the opportunity to hear from our Principal as well as our HOD/ PE & CCA who will share on the school's CCA programme. You will also have an opportunity to interact with your child/ward's Form Teachers to find out more about your child/ ward's experiences and progress for the first three weeks in school.

We will inform you the Zoom meeting details nearer the date.

3.3 Developing Self-Discipline and Responsibility

a) Attire and Grooming

Students are expected to wear the prescribed uniform and no modification to the uniform is allowed. Long pants are not allowed to be tapered or shortened above the ankles. Similarly, the length of school skirts must be just above the knees. All school uniform including PE and House T-shirts must be worn with the student's nametag sewn on the right side in line with the school crest / logo. This is to ensure safety and security when staff are identifying students during flag raising or school events.

Students not adhering to the above guidelines will be asked to rectify their uniforms or have their uniforms confiscated.

b) Handphone and Electronic Device Policy

To nurture an environment conducive for teaching and learning, students are strongly discouraged from bringing handphones or other forms of electronic devices to school. Should students decide to bring these devices to school, they must take personal responsibility to care for their own belongings and valuables.



To encourage focus on learning, all handphones and electronic devices (if brought to school) are to be switched off and kept in the school bag at all times. Handphones and electronic devices may only be used at designated Phone Zones, namely the canteen and the foyer, during recess and before / after school.

The school takes a firm stand towards the use of handphones and electronic devices in the school premises. Kindly remind your child/ward that handphones and electronic devices will be confiscated by teachers should it be used in contravention of the above quidelines.

c) Absenteeism

The school places great emphasis on student learning and hence strongly discourages frequent absenteeism as such behaviour disrupts the child's learning and affects his/her performance. Together, with your support, we can develop and inculcate in your child/ward the right attitude towards school and learning, which he/she will carry with him/her in his/her future work and endeavours.

We seek your support to monitor your child's/ward's attendance closely, and ensure he/she does not stay away from school. Absenteeism should be substantiated with **medical certificates only**. Students who are absent without valid reasons will face disciplinary consequences.

d) Target Setting and Monitoring

The school will support your child's/ward's learning through target setting and monitoring via the Student Handbook and Individualised Target Cards. We hope that you and your child/ward can thus focus and monitor his/her performance responsibly throughout the year. With the help and supervision of parents/guardians at home, we are confident your child/ward will be one step closer to achieving his/her targets.
